This targeted support for those in education focuses on those who are;

- In and leaving Local Authority care
- Identified as having a special educational need and an EHCP
- On SEN Support
- Young Carers
- Struggling to engage with education due to specific needs e.g. medical needs
- Known or at risk of becoming known to, or returning to, the Criminal Justice System or at risk of being exploited
- Young Parents

We are also commissioned by the Local Authority to work with young people who are unemployed and aged 16-19. We help them to understand the range of options available to them and support them to access opportunities and services through signposting, brokerage and referrals.

We have a team of highly qualified and experienced advisers who have excellent working knowledge of local provision and options. Our advisers can provide face to face, phone or online support. Our advisers have excellent links with training providers, educational establishments and various other youth based organisations.
